

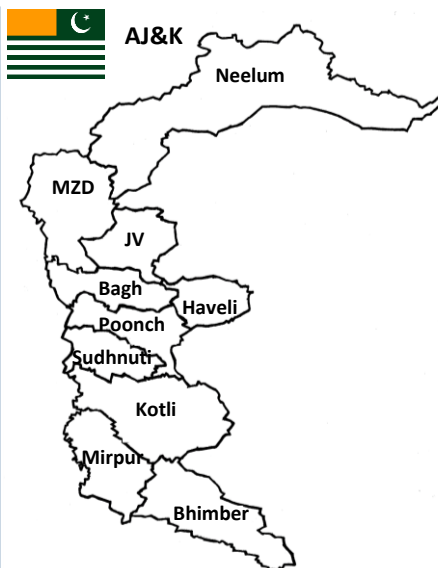

MESSAGE OF THE WEEK



Highlights

- The overall reporting compliance rate stands at 99.6 %, indicating strong adherence.
- During Epi week 18, the most frequently reported cases were of Acute Diarrhea (Non-Cholera) followed by ILI, Pneumonia/ALRI, Tuberculosis, Animal / Dog Bite and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection.
- Among Water / Food Borne Diseases, Acute Diarrhea (Non-Cholera) cases have decreased this week.
- No death reported during this week
- 04 cases of Acute Flaccid Paralysis reported this week.
- 112 cases of Animal / Dog Bite reported during Epi week 18.
- 05 cases of chickenpox / Varicella have been reported during this week.
- This week, 112 tuberculosis cases have been reported (58 cases from district Poonch)

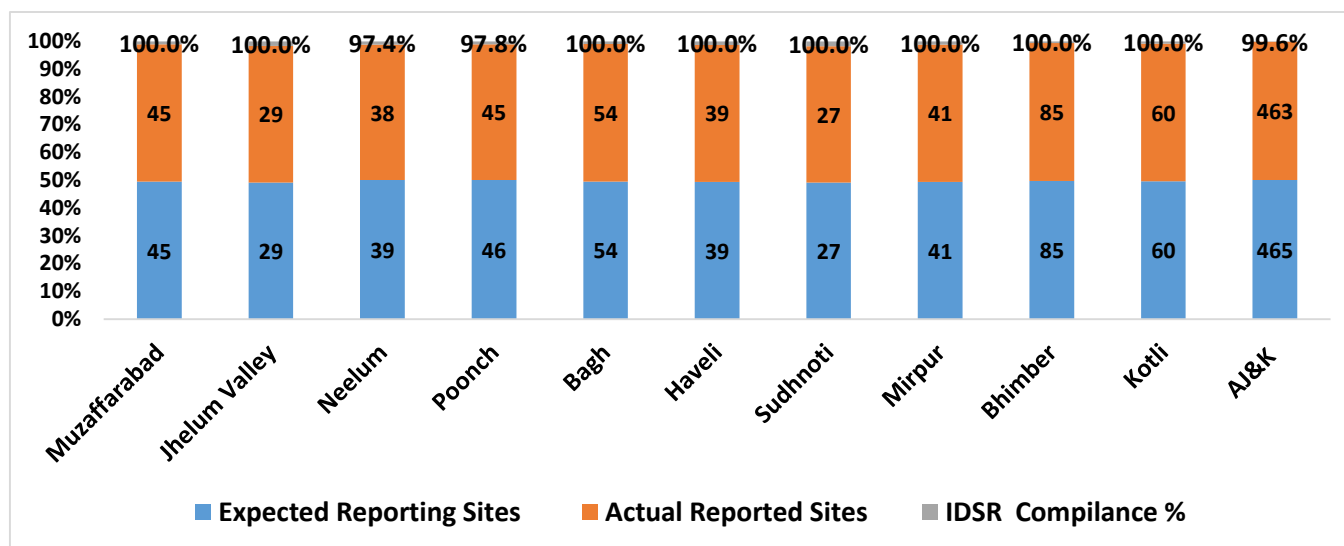


A comprehensive training session on “Disease Surveillance & Levels of Prevention” was conducted for LHS's and Sector Incharges by IDSRS Team district Haveli.

Figure: 1 Compliance Rate of Reporting Sites (Epi Week 18)



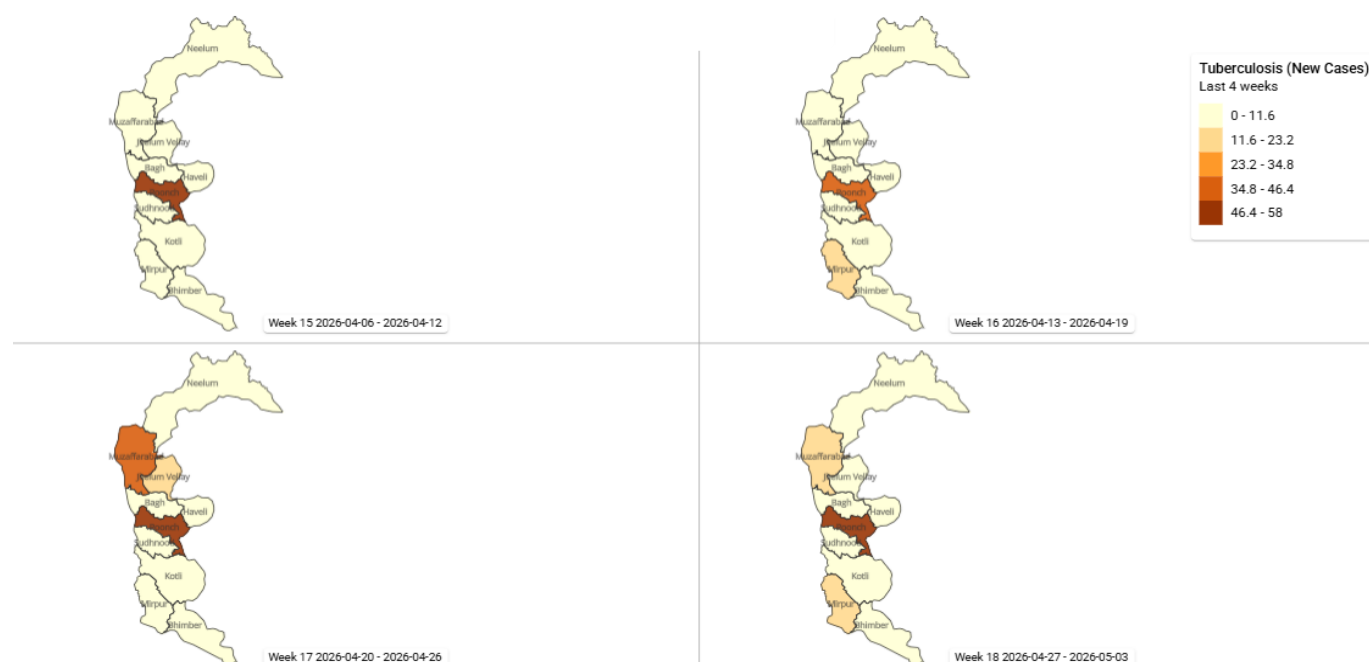

Figure: 2 Trend of Suspected ILI Cases (Epi Week 26, 2025-Week 18, 2026)

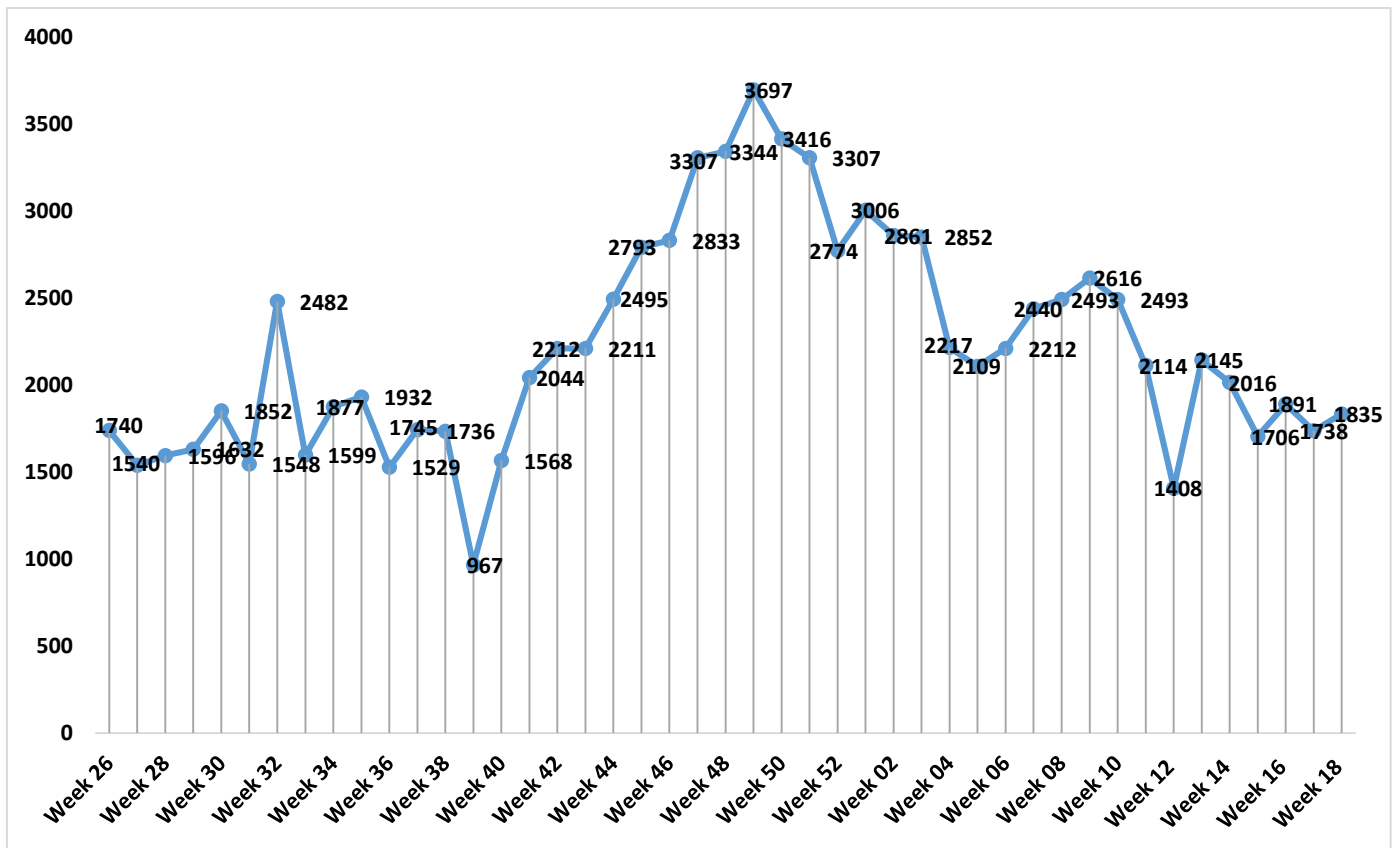


Figure: 3 Trend of Suspected Acute Diarrhea (Non-Cholera) Cases (Epi week 26, 2025 –week 18, 2026)

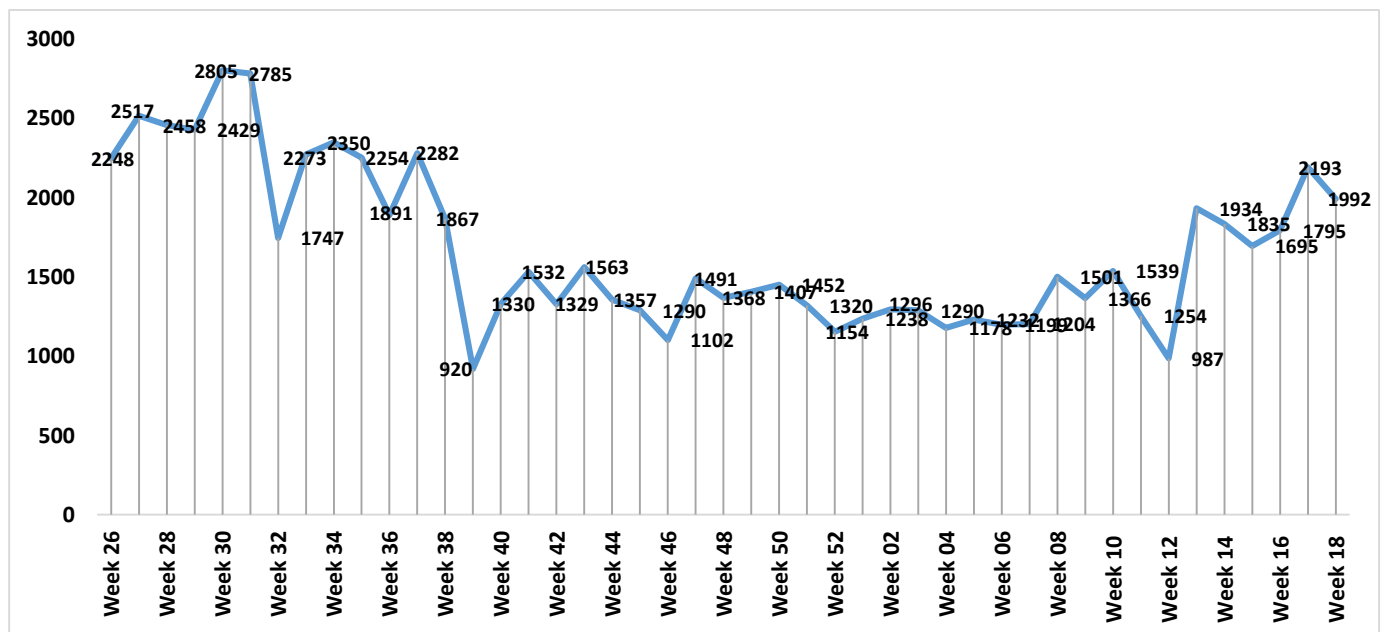


Figure: 4 Weekly Comparison of Vaccine Preventable Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)

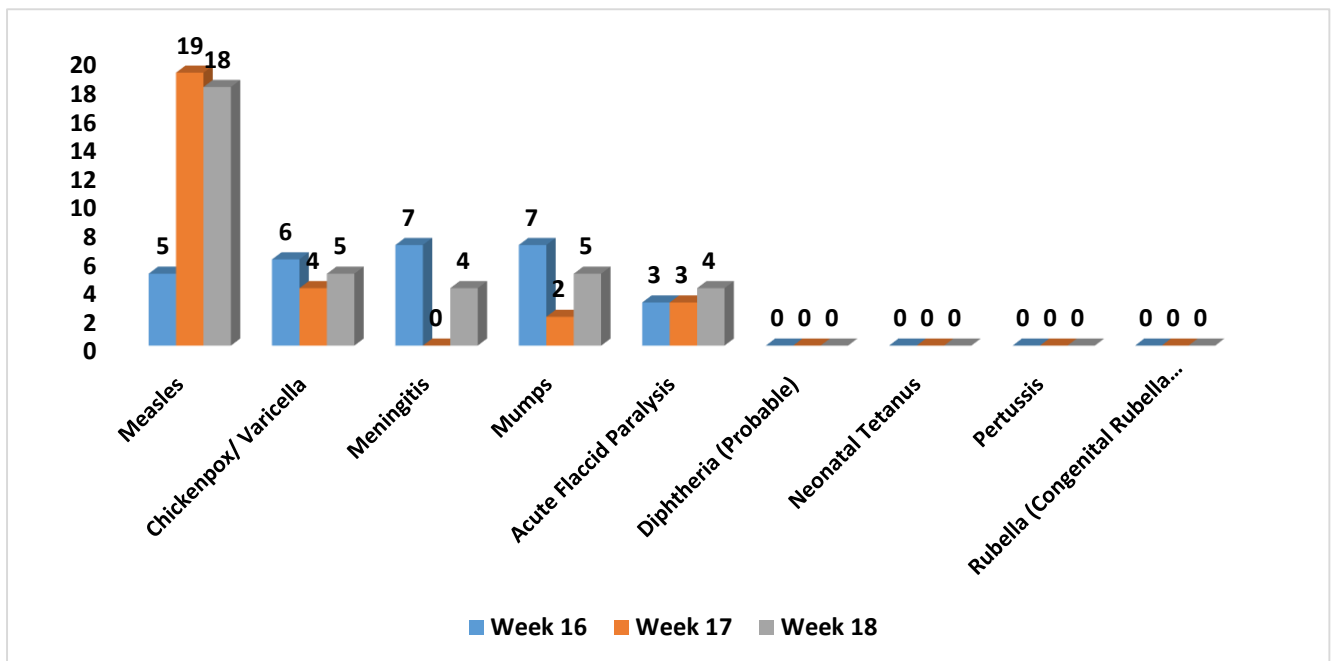


Figure: 5 Weekly Comparison of Respiratory Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)

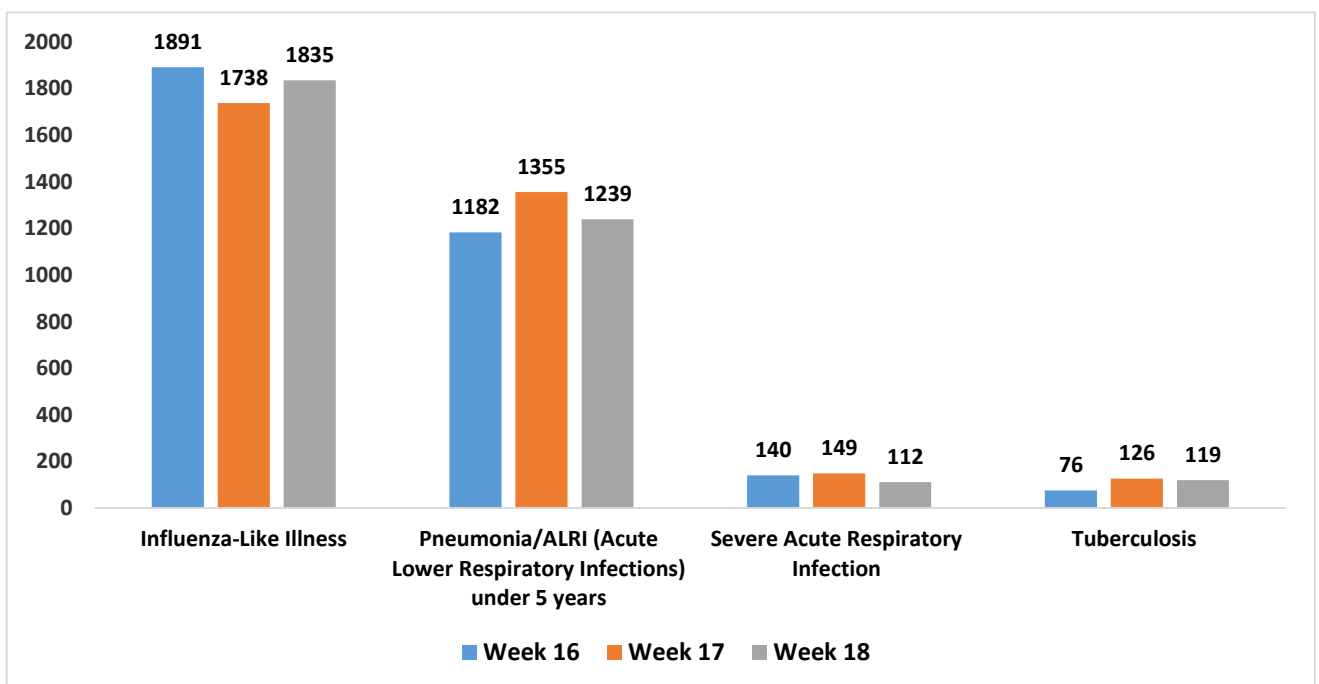


Figure: 6 Weekly Comparison of Water / Food Borne Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)

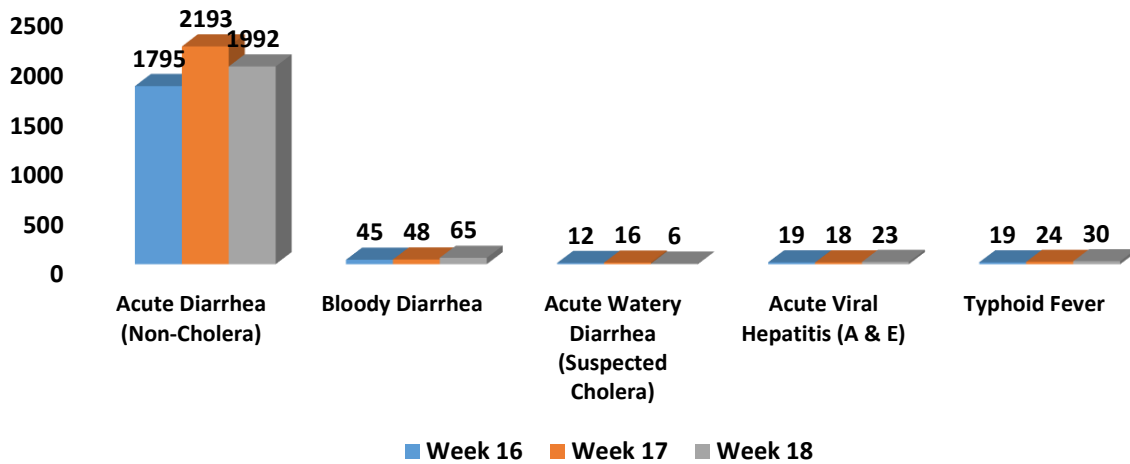


Figure: 7 Weekly Comparison of Sexually Transmitted Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)

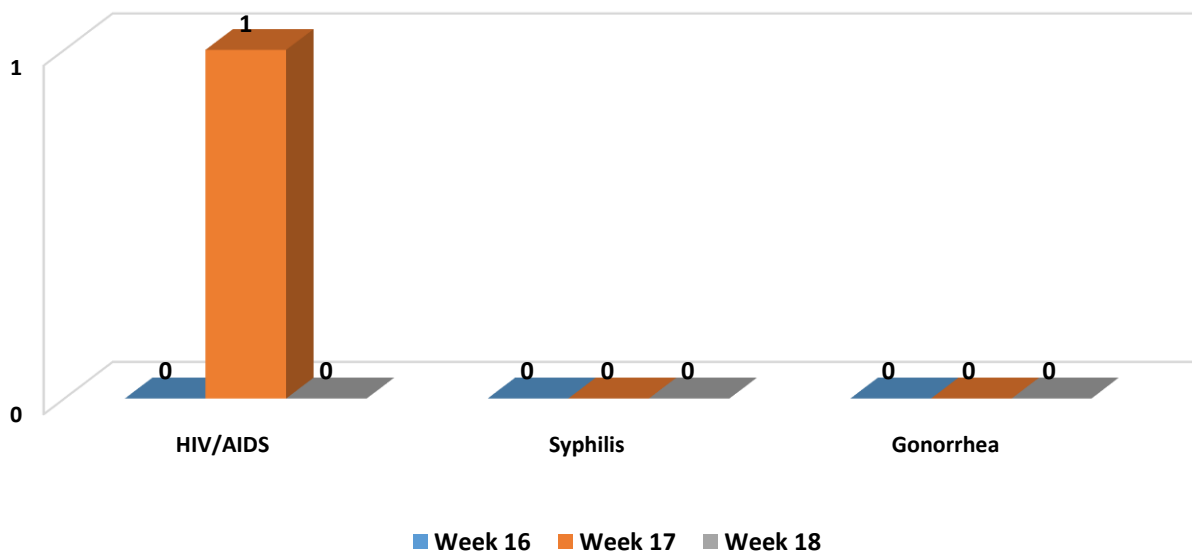


Figure: 8 Weekly Comparison of Zoonotic / Other Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)

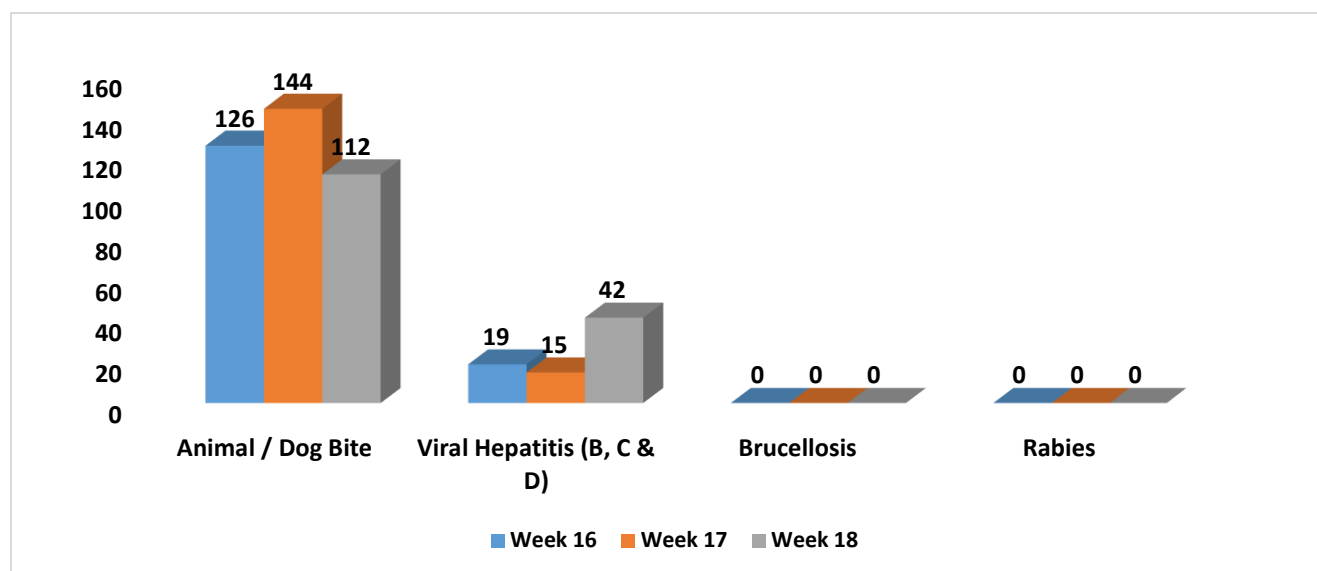
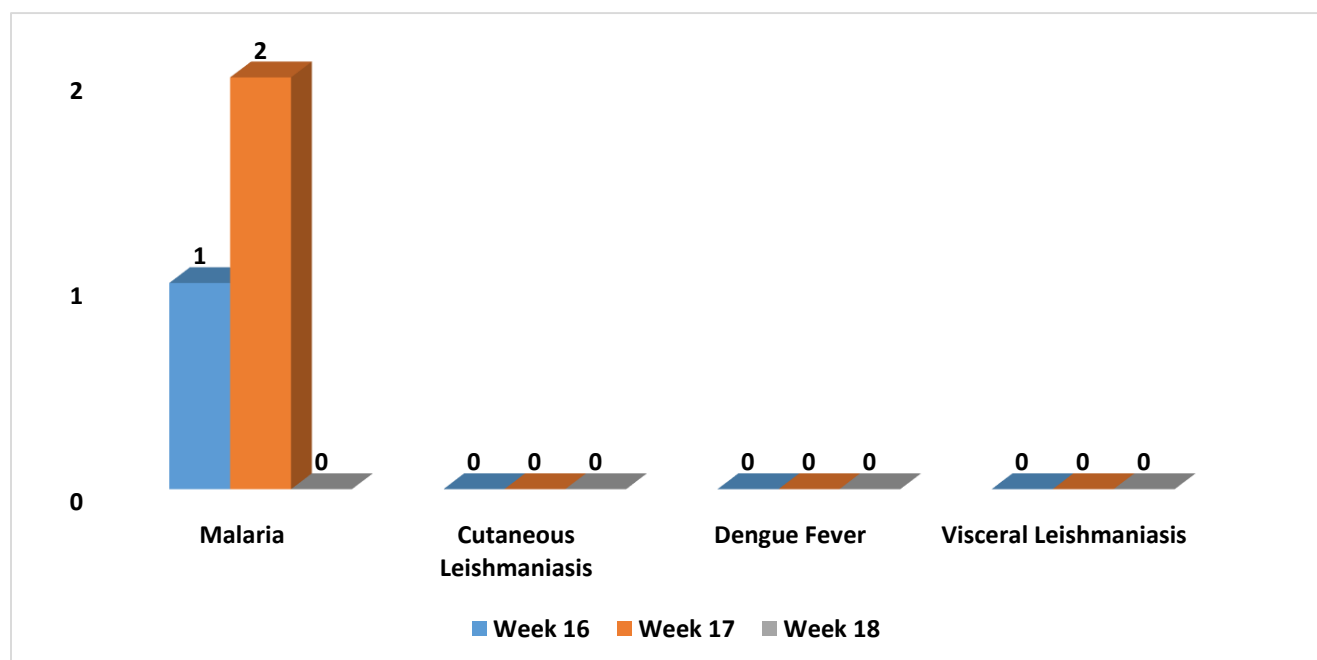


Figure: 9 Weekly Comparison of Vector Borne Diseases in AJ&K (Last 03 Weeks)



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
